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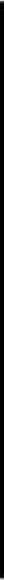
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About DTT 01

02 Message from the chairman



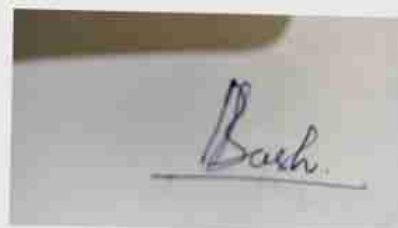
Dear Supporters,

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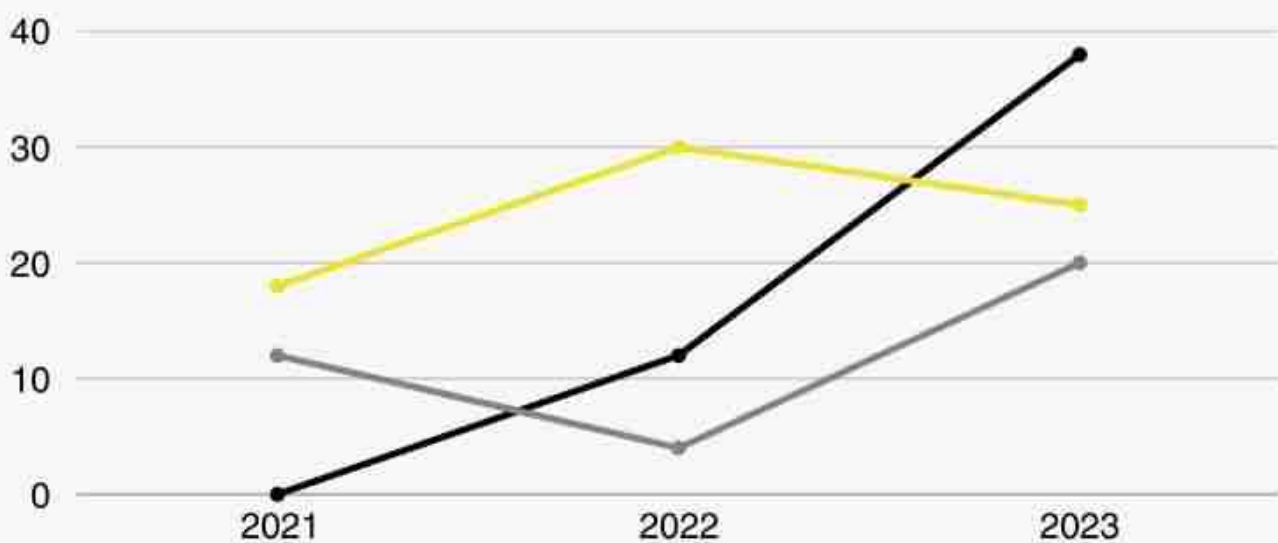

Women Empowerment & Sustainable Livelihoods

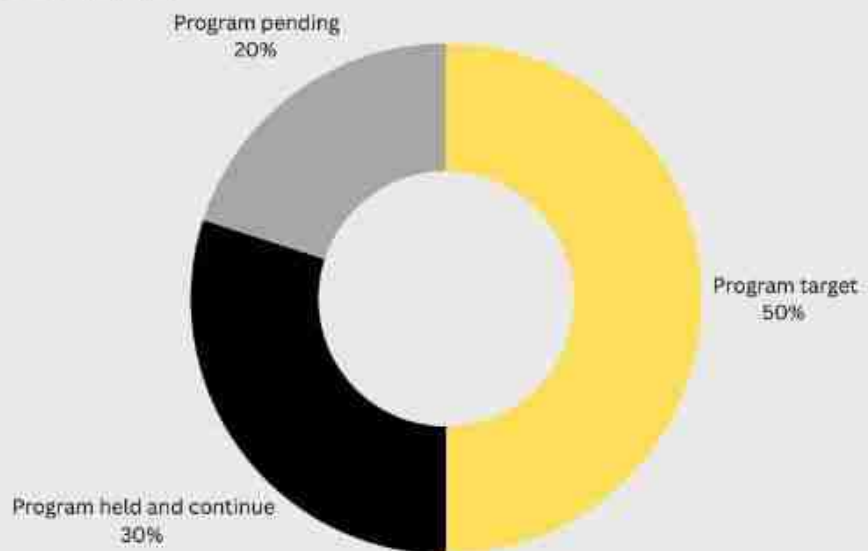
- Expanded Self-Help Groups (SHGs) for women in Kujanga and Paradip areas
