

### Women empowerment and sustainability program

Tlhe **Dattopant Thengadi Trust (DTT)** is deeply committed to empowering women and promoting sustainable livelihoods, especially in rural and marginalized communities. Through its grassroots initiatives, DTT helps women become financially independent, socially confident, and environmentally responsible.

Key Focus Areas

#### - Formation of Self-Help Groups (SHGs)

Women are organized into SHGs to promote savings, access microcredit, and start income-generating activities.

#### - Skill Development & Livelihood Training

Training programs in dairy farming, tailoring, handicrafts, and food processing help women build sustainable sources of income.

#### - Dairy Farming as a Sustainable Model

DTT promotes dairy farming as a reliable and ecofriendly livelihood option, enabling women to earn while contributing to local nutrition and agriculture.

#### Leadership & Community Engagement

Women are encouraged to take leadership roles within their groups and communities, fostering decisionmaking and collective action.

## TERRACOTTA CRAFT & VISWAKARMA SCHEME AWARENESS





- On the occasion of National Labour Day, the Dattopant Thejgadi Trust (DTT) visited Nunukua Village, under Kothi Gram Panchayat, Kujanga Block, to engage with the local Kumbhar (potter) community—the traditional artisans known for their exquisite terracotta work.
- Terracotta, a time-honored cottage industry, represents the cultural heritage and craftsmanship of rural Odisha. During the visit, our team interacted with the artisans and informed them about the inclusion of Terracotta Workunder the PM Viswakarma Scheme, launched by the Government of India to support traditional craftspeople.

Key Highlights of the Visit

- Explained the scope and benefits of the Viswakarma Scheme, including:
- Financial assistance and skill development
- Access to modern tools and technology
- Marketing support and digital empowerment
- Social security and insurance coverage for artisans and their families
- Encouraged the artisans to register under the scheme to avail its full benefits
- Discussed ways to preserve and promote terracotta art as a sustainable livelihood option

This initiative reflects DTT's commitment to uplifting traditional workers, preserving cultural industries, and ensuring that artisans are included in the journey toward a Vikashit Bharat.



## All programs of DTT

The Shramika Posana Panchayat Programis a flagship initiative of the Dattopant Thengadi Trust (DTT)aimed at uplifting the lives of labourers and their families through social security, skill development, and civic awareness.

This program is especially active in regions where large numbers of workers are employed in industrial sectors, such as IOCL Paradip Refinery. It focuses on building worker-friendly Panchayats that prioritize the welfare, dignity, and development of the labour force.

#### **Key Objectives**

- Promote social security schemes like insurance and pension for workers and their families
- Conduct awareness meetings on voter rights, civic duties, and participation in democratic processes
- Facilitate access to government welfare programs for labourers
- Encourage community leadership among workers to strengthen local governance
- Support health, sanitation, and education initiatives in labour-dense areas

#### Recent Activity

On National Labour Day, DTT organized a special awareness meeting in **Gopiakuda GP** where **52 Panchayat leaders** participated. The session focused on:

- Educating workers about their rights and responsibilities
- Promoting insurance coverage as a form of social protection
- Encouraging full participation in the electoral process
- Strengthening the role of Panchayats in labour welfare

- Enhance Voter Awareness & Civic Engagement Conduct regular workshops to educate citizens on electoral rights, responsibilities, and democratic participation.
- Digital Empowerment & Skill Development Provide digital literacy and vocational training to youth and women, preparing them for modern livelihood opportunities.
