


## **About DTT**

## OUR PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS



As part of our commitment to the Swachh Bharat Mission, a series of health and sanitation awareness programs were successfully organized across various locations in Paradip Municipality and Kujanga Block, engaging local communities and promoting hygienic living practices.

#### Key Activities & Impact

#### -Bhitaragada Colony, Ward No. 4 – Paradip Municipality

On 1st January 2024, a comprehensive health and sanitation awareness campaign was conducted in Bhitaragada Colony. The initiative reached approximately 700 households, directly benefiting over 3,000 residents through educational outreach, cleanliness drives, and distribution of hygiene materials.

#### - Ward No. 1 – Paradip Municipality

A follow-up campaign was held on **21st September 2024**, focusing on sanitation awareness and community
engagement. Local residents actively participated in
discussions and activities aimed at improving public
hygiene.

#### -Laxminarayan Temple, Balia GP - Kujanga Block

On **21st January 2024**, a Swachh Bharat cleanliness drive was organized at the temple premises, involving local volunteers and community leaders. The program aimed to maintain religious and public spaces with dignity and cleanliness.

#### - Badabandha Village - Kujanga Block

On the same day, a parallel initiative was conducted in Badabandha Village, where 15 women volunteers took the lead in cleaning the village temple and surrounding areas. This grassroots effort is expected to **benefit over 1,000 villagers**, fostering a culture of responsibility and collective action.

#### Voter Rights & Social Security Awareness - Gopiakuda GP

A Voter Rights Awareness Meeting was organized at **Gopiakuda Gram Panchayat**, focusing on the importance of active participation in the electoral process and access to social security for workers.

The session was attended by 52 Panchayat-level leaders, many of whom represent the Shramik Posan Panchayat, where a large number of residents are employed at IOCL Paradip Refinery.

Key highlights of the meeting included:

- Emphasis on the right to vote as a fundamental duty of every citizen
- Encouragement for all workers and their families to participate in upcoming elections

- Discussion on the need for insurance coverage and social security schemes to

protect workers and their dependents

- Assurance from attendees to follow government-issued social security guidelines and promote awareness in their communities

This initiative helped strengthen civic responsibility and highlighted the role of social protection in building a secure and empowered workforce—aligned with the broader mission of Vikashit Bharat.
